

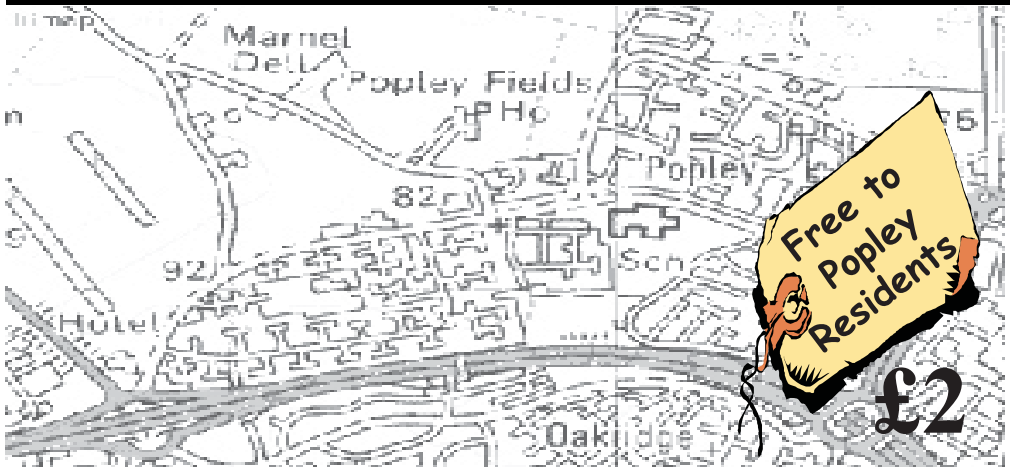

## Talking Health

We are the NHS North Hampshire Clinical Commissioning Group and our job is to plan and buy your local healthcare services. We work closely with GP Practices, pharmacies and other healthcare professionals to give you the best possible service.

Here is another of our short hints, tips and ideas articles about how to better look after yourself, your family and your neighbours.

### Stay Well This Winter

We're looking forward to another winter which will bring with it the usual aches, pains, colds, sniffles and sore throats many of us experience each year.

Taking care of ourselves and our families is top priority at any time of year, but even more so now. There are some simple steps to take which will keep you and your loved ones out of hospital and even out of the doctor's surgery.

First of all, ask your local pharmacist as soon as you feel unwell, before it becomes too serious. They are a great source of information and health advice and will have a consultation room if you prefer to talk in private.

With Christmas and New Year holidays approaching, make sure you have your prescriptions and all medication before 24<sup>th</sup> December. Expecting visitors? Ask them to bring enough medicines – not forgetting they may stay longer than expected if the weather prevents safe travel.

It's particularly important for young children and the elderly to stay warm and eat well, so stock up on food supplies, have plenty of hot drinks, wear warm clothes, and try to warm your home to at least 18°C. Check on your neighbours too, especially if they are frail and you haven't seen them for a few days. If you are worried about an elderly neighbour call the Age UK helpline on 0800 00 99 66.

An increasing number of people are now eligible for a free flu vaccination, which is well worth it. People who qualify are:

- Those aged 65 years and over
- Those aged six months to under 65 in clinical risk groups
- Pregnant women
- All two-, three- and four-year-olds (but not five years or older) on 31 August 2015
- All children of school years 1 and 2 age
- Those in long-stay residential care homes
- Carers.

If this means **you** please contact your GP Practice soon.

Looking after yourself and your family is vital. You will have heard in the news that the NHS is increasingly stretched so we need to save the services of the Emergency Departments for those who are at highest risk.

Let's all look after ourselves, our families, friends and neighbours – and stay well this winter.

**Councillors' Page:** I know everyone is getting frustrated with all the roadworks. They seem to be just about everywhere, and there is more to come with roadworks for several months at both ends of Popley. The roads were neglected for so long that only major works will bring them back to a reasonable state.

I had to report a blockage of our sewage drains five times in two months. I was told that in this case, and in most other cases, it is "wipes", oil and fats that clog up the drains. Please dispose of wipes in your dustbins and oils and fats also.

At the full council meeting £98 million of cuts to services were put to the vote and, of course, I voted against these massive cuts that will have a impact on the most vulnerable in the county.

There are warnings of a severe winter and the County has already ordered grit bins and say they are ready when needed. They are for use to keep the highways open and not for private drives and paths. I will be requesting some grit bins for Marnel Park as this is the first year that they are adopted highways, though there are still a few roads that still have not been handed over due to the developers needing to do some remedial work first. **Popley West:** The experimental traffic order came into effect in Marnel Park on 9th October it will run for about six months and any comments for or against should be sent to Local Government and Litigation Team (01256) 845243.

The Beat the Street scheme is proving very popular and exceeding all expectations. At the two week stage of the six weeks programme it has already reached 60% of the whole six weeks programme.

We attended the first Popley Neighbourhood Partnership where we hope that residents, agencies, businesses, groups schools and anyone living or working in Popley will be able to shape the priorities for our area. There will be a further meeting on 18th November. There will be access to grant money where the residents will be able to vote the priorities. We will keep you informed via Popley Matters.

I went to the Mayor's Charity Concert and was very proud to see some of our children sing in a schools choir and they were amazing. Well done Merton Junior School.

We will be attending the Remembrance Sunday services at the Civic Offices on 8th November for the service and 11th November for the two minute silence. Everyone is welcome to come for both events.

**Popley East:** The Bermuda and Marlowe Practice at Shakespeare House Health Centre is subject to a procurement process and will shortly be put out to tender for new contract to be applied from 1 April 2016.

Cllr David Potter has been co-opted onto the Patient Participation Group and is actively involved in this procurement process.

This is likely to be completed by the end of this year or shortly thereafter and we believe that the local community will endorse our efforts to secure continuity of care and support for the local community provided by the current practice's Doctors, Nurse Practitioners and support staff.

We will keep the community informed of developments through Popley Matters and leaflets.

We have reported schemes in Popley which are being promoted and supported by Local Infrastructure Fund money.

This is money which is generated because of the new homes which have been built in particular areas, and Popley has taken more than its fair share over recent years.

We are arguing that a wider use of this money should be supported to enable regeneration schemes to be undertaken in parts of the ward where areas of deprivation can be identified. In this way Popley will benefit from the new development it has experienced on a wider community basis.

Dear Friends

There's an old joke that goes something like this: Three ministers are discussing how they got rid of mice in their churches. The Pentecostal minister says "We prayed against their presence, and then they all left." The Baptist minister says "We preached against their presence, and then they all left". And the Church of England minister says "We baptised them all, and we haven't seen them in church since." If I'm honest it feels a bit like that at times in St Gabriel's!

It is one of the greatest privileges of my ministry to conduct Christenings and they are always cause for great celebration. It is always so lovely to meet parents, Godparents, family and friends and afterwards there is usually a party somewhere with most probably, jelly and ice cream, where everyone can have a great time.

Many of the parents say that they always mean to keep the promises they've made and bring their children to church but once they stop coming as part of the preparation it becomes harder and harder to start again – mostly through a sense of embarrassment at not coming and what people might say or think about them.

This isn't uncommon! How many times do we make promises to family, friends, and neighbours, or people we meet on holiday and get on well with? We promise to keep in touch with them "I'll give you a call" we say, and we always mean to, but the daily pressures of life seem to pile in and time goes by so quick that, before you know it, months have slipped by and we feel so embarrassed about not keeping in touch that we're afraid to pick up the phone or stick our heads around the door for fear of rejection. I know because I've been there, done that and got the T-shirt!

It's been my experience that this is most usually an irrational fear! People are always glad to hear from old friends or family that they haven't seen or spoken to for a while – some folk are just glad to hear from someone - anyone!

If you haven't been to church for a while and you've been meaning to come but just feel too shy or that it might be too embarrassing, then may I invite you, personally, to come along one Sunday morning to St Gabriel's - no questions asked, no judgements passed, believe me when I say, it would be a pleasure to see you and to remake old acquaintance.

Jesus told the parable of the shepherd who lost one of his hundred sheep and left the other ninety-nine to go in search of that one that was lost. He is still searching today for those that have wandered away, longing to find them and to bring them home to great rejoicing. In these uncertain times we could all do with the holding on to someone as changeless as the Son of God who promises a welcome to any who would come to Him.

I continue to look forward to seeing many of you soon and catching up on all your news. With every blessing in Christ.

## Sham redundancies – are you a victim?

There are not many families that have avoided that dreaded word 'redundancy'. It is hard enough for employees to come to terms with their employment being terminated when there is a genuine redundancy situation. It becomes impossible when their employer just uses the term redundancy as an excuse to dismiss when there are no genuine grounds for doing so.

An employer can only lawfully dismiss you for a potentially fair reason under English law. These reasons are:

1. Capability – where they believe you are unable to do your job properly, e.g. underperformance, inability to work with colleagues or because of persistent or long-term sick leave.
2. Misconduct – where you have been found guilty of gross misconduct or a series of acts of misconduct which you have been disciplined for.
3. Statutory restriction – where your ongoing employment would break the law, e.g. a lorry driver who has been disqualified from driving.
4. Redundancy – where the employer's requirement for employees to carry out work of a particular kind has ceased or reduced.
5. Some other substantial reason (SOSR) - a 'catch-all' category which applies if there is a substantial reason to dismiss, e.g. refusing to accept reasonable changes following a business reorganisation.

Employers will often look to avoid dismissing employees where they have a potentially fair reason to dismiss, such as on capability, misconduct or SOSR grounds, due to the time-consuming procedures in place which they would be expected to follow.

Sometimes employers wish to dismiss for discriminatory reasons (e.g. because of the employee's age, sex, race, disability, sexual orientation, gender reassignment, religion or belief etc), for automatically unfair reasons (e.g. because the employee has complained about issues relating to health and safety, working time, minimum wage, flexible working or perhaps because an employee has whistle-blown or joined a trade union) and so they seek to dismiss under the guise of a redundancy.

For a redundancy dismissal to be fair, there must be a genuine redundancy situation, the employee must have been fairly selected for redundancy and the employer must have followed a fair procedure. When determining the fairness of a redundancy dismissal Employment Tribunals are not normally entitled to investigate the reasons behind the redundancy situation.

There is no requirement for employers to demonstrate that they were forced into making redundancies because of economic reasons, a sound commercial reason which can be objectively justified will suffice. This does not mean to say that they will always take the employer's reason at face value, especially where an employee establishes facts which suggest that their selection was discriminatory and the redundancy situation was a sham.

It is important to know that there are very short time limits that apply to Employment Tribunal claims, e.g. three months (less one day) from the date of dismissal or the date of the discriminatory act, so if you think your dismissal for redundancy was a sham, don't delay in seeking advice as you could be prevented from bringing a claim if your time limit has expired.

I just wanted to say what a marvellous idea the ‘Beat the Streets’ installation is. I’m not sure if this is a Hampshire County Council (HCC) or Basingstoke and Deane Borough (BDBC) led scheme, but it’s brilliant to see so many young families exploring the whole of Popley – new and old.

We already know the area well owing to our dog walking, and it was great to see so many other people getting to know the area too, so they can see what a generally safe place it is to walk, cycle and scoot and will show them the many different routes to school, shops etc. and encouraging sustainable travel.

Not only that, but it will provide valuable data to HCC and BDBC about the most popular routes people are taking, where people are walking (and avoiding), the distances people are walking etc. and establish very clearly where the ‘hotspots’ are. A win-win scenario! *Steve*
